

Sidewalk Chalk

Texture, shading, contrast, linework. Sidewalk Chalk uses its fiber medium to maximum effect. Each remnant of reclaimed silk, wool, and linen is artfully arranged by the artist in the style of abstract expressionism and then felted by hundreds of tiny needles. Once interwoven, the fabrics become painterly in their array of color washes and opaque overlaps. Satisfying daubs of pure white appear, as do chalky outlines made from former shirt seams. It is truly one of a kind.
